Respiratory disease is one of the leading causes of death and disability in the United States. With the emergence of COVID-19, therapists are treating even greater numbers of clients with compromised lung function. As a result, rehabilitation professionals must be prepared to provide effective rehabilitation for their clients with respiratory deficits.
