

Hockney has owned a residence and studio in Bridlington and London, as well as two residences in California, where he has lived intermittently since 1964: one in the Hollywood Hills, one in Malibu...On 15 November 2018, Hockney's 1972 work *Portrait of an Artist (Pool with Two Figures)* sold at Christie's auction house in New York City for \$90 million, becoming the most expensive artwork by a living artist sold at auction. This broke the previous record, set by the 2013 sale of Jeff Koons' *Balloon Dog (Orange)* for \$58.4 million. Hockney held this record until 15 May 2019. Jeff Koons reclaimed the honor when his *Rabbit* sold for more than \$91 million at Christie's in New York."
