 - Cleaning and disinfection of environmental surfaces and resident care equipment




Assessment – Results

Total	1075




Does at least one staff member receive SIREN alerts?

Visitors

	Completed	In progress	Not started
Facility restricts all visitors except for compassionate care	98%	1%	1%
Facility screens allowed visitors and restricts anyone with symptoms, contact with a COVID-19 case, or travel to affected areas	97%	1%	2%
Facility has provided alternative methods for visitation (e.g., video conferencing)	91%	7%	2%

"We are using FaceTime, Skype, visits through windows and cell phones, cards and letters are all helping ease residents at this time."

"FaceTime/Video Chats are difficult for some residents with hearing loss and some don't grasp the concept."

Healthcare personnel (HCP)

	Completed	In progress	Not started
Facility screens all HCP at the beginning of their shift for fever and respiratory symptoms.	97%	3%	<1%
Facility has established a plan for when HCP with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 can return to work	94%	6%	<1%
Facility keeps a list of symptomatic HCP	Yes 94%	No <1%	N/A 6%

"...we have several staff members who work in multiple facilities and we would like to be informed of outbreaks in other facilities so we can take the necessary precautions..."

"Staff anxiety and fear of acquiring the infection can be a challenge."

Residents

	Yes	No
Facility actively monitors all residents (at least daily) for fever and respiratory symptoms (shortness of breath, new or change in cough, sore throat, and pulse oximetry).	97%	3%
Residents with suspected respiratory infections are immediately placed in Contact/Droplet Precautions with eye protection	95%	5%
Facility has established criteria for closing units or the entire facility to new admissions	76%	24%

"At this time facility is not admitting COVID-19 positive patients and requests clarification from IDPH as to transferring facility's requirement to test before discharge to SNF."

"Tips/techniques for middle to late stage Alzheimer's patients if we do get a COVID case. ... Limiting activities increases behaviors..."

Additional Infection Control Actions


	Yes	No
Facility has a hand hygiene monitoring program	73%	27%
Facility has implemented universal use of facemasks for HCP while in the facility*	38%	62%
 Facility notifies the health department about any of the following: COVID-19 is suspected or confirmed in a resident or healthcare provider A resident has severe respiratory infection A cluster (e.g., ≥ 3 residents or HCP with new-onset respiratory 	100%	<1%
symptoms over 72 hours) of residents or HCP with symptoms of respiratory infection is identified.


