## OVERVIEW

The Assisted Living Bootcamp 1.0 curriculum has been designed to give new and not-so-new Assisted Living operators and managers a deep dive into the Illinois' Assisted Living and Shared Housing Act. This workshop will also cover what individuals need to do to be in compliance with the act, and the most common legal issues facing providers today.

The IDPH team will provide an in-depth review of the Assisted Living Code, an overview of the survey process, the most problematic and frequently cited areas, and the Department's expectations for achieving regulatory compliance. Life Safety Code survey process will also be addressed. Ample time will be allotted for participant questions.

Polsinelli attorneys will review the most common operational challenges that have led to significant liability, including Alzheimer's care, navigating staffing issues, and dealing with difficult families. They will discuss the forces impacting legal and regulatory compliance through case studies and offer practical guidance and best practices to navigate these challenges.

## OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of this educational offering, participants will be able to:

- Thoroughly understand the Illinois Assisted Living and Shared Housing Act, with particular focus on the challenges to the regulations
- Correlate the state of Illinois regulations with corporate expectations
- Identify Illinois Department of Public Health's criteria for maintaining compliance
- Describe the top legal concerns impacting Assisted Living and what individuals need to do to successfully negotiate through these landmines
- Evaluate current operational practices for regulatory and legal compliance and employ strategies for corrective action
