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Post Test - Resident Visitation Rights

Question	Answer
1. A resident’s son who is verbally abusive states he has as much right to visit as a next door neighbor. The resident and/or resident representative has the right to refuse visitation with her son.	
2. The right to privacy means that the resident is able to use a private location in the facility for visitation such as a vacant chapel, unoccupied common or room or an activities area when there are not activities planned.	
3. A resident is able to visit with a friend of theirs at 10 pm at night.	
4. Any representative of the State responsible for the advocacy of an individual with disabilities may be provided with immediate access.	
5. The facility may limit visitation of family members who frequently complain to staff.	
6. The facility may need to limit visitation during an infection outbreak.	
7. The night shift nurse can make the State surveyor wait until the Administrator comes to the building before they can talk to the resident.
