1. PASARR stands for Please Admit Several Acute Respiratory Residents.	False – PASARR Preadmission Screening And Annual Resident Review
2. The Level I Screen is completed 48 hours after admission.	False – It is completed prior to admission into the facility
3. The PASARR screen assists organizations in determining if an individual may have a mental disorder, intellectual disability or a related condition.	True - The purpose of this screen is to be completed during the preadmission process and identify if an individual has a mental disorder, ID or related condition which would warrant additional screening
4. All potential residents to our facility require a Level I screen.	True – All individuals no matter pay type, require a Level I screen to be completed
5. The level II recommendations, if agreed upon, need to be coordinated into the care process including: assessment, care plan and specialized services.	True – The PASARR process is part of the care coordination for care and services delivered by the facility
