	Question	Answer
1.	If a resident is on contact precautions and they only want me to turn on a fan, it is okay if I just run in and do that without following the isolation precautions because I am not actually providing personal care.	False. You are required to follow the directions whenever you enter the room. If there are exceptions, they will be identified in the directions.
2.	As long as I am wearing gloves, I don't always have to wash my hands.	False. Hand hygiene should be provided before AND after wearing gloves.
3.	Residents with new respiratory symptoms should be provided with facemasks.	True
4.	I cannot work if I have infected hand lesions that may come in contact with the residents or their food.	True
5.	I can contract an infectious disease if I come in contact with a contaminated piece of equipment.	True
6.	Standard Precautions includes all body fluids, secretions, excretions EXCEPT sweat-even if they don't contain visible blood.	True
